B. Employment

4011 Application

Every applicant for employment shall be required to complete the official application form in every detail and attest to its accuracy. Inaccurate or incomplete information on this application form may result in disqualification. For an application to receive consideration, it shall be filed in the Human Resources Office within the published deadline dates.

In filing an application, the applicant gives the District the right to investigate the person's background and to secure confidential information which may affect the decision to employ.

Disqualification of Applicants

Any applicant shall be disqualified for employment if the person:

1. has been convicted of a sex offense or narcotics offense as defined in state law, unless otherwise provided by law;
2. has been determined to be a sexual psychopath under provisions of law in this or any other state.

Applicants may also be disqualified for other reasons provided by law.
