B. Admission and Attendance

5121 Fees *

1. Enrollment Fee

All students, with the exception of those who have been exempted by law, will be required to pay an enrollment fee at the time they enroll in classes. This fee will be based upon the total number of units and will reflect adherence to Education Code and/or Title 5 guidelines and provisions.

The District will refund a portion of the enrollment fee under the procedural guidelines established in accordance with required code and regulations; except in cases where the refund request is due to military withdrawal (MW). Full refund shall be made to those persons receiving an "MW".

Instruments as determined by the appropriate Administrative and Education Code sections, and as described in the Administrative Rules and Procedures, will be utilized in the granting of fee credit(s) and waivers and enrollment fee deferments.

2. Materials Fee

Materials fee reflecting the actual cost of consumable materials will be charged for classes as designated.

3. Parking Fee

A parking fee will be charged each semester. Revenue so generated will be used to provide for the parking service and related expenses.

Parking fees for disabled students with current DMV placard may be waived by the College Vice President of Student Services based on financial need.

4. Health Fee

A health fee will be charged each semester. Revenue so generated will be used for health services.
