### **Administrative Rules and Procedures**

#### **5125 Admission of International Students (F-I Visa) (M-1 Visa)**

The District will admit International Students under the following conditions:

1. Admission and enrollment procedures regarding international student applicants shall be maintained pursuant to applicable Title 5 and Education Code Sections and within the guidelines established by Immigration and Naturalization Services.
2. Students seeking admission shall: a) provide evidence of having completed the equivalent of a high school education; b) demonstrate their ability to read and write English at the twelfth (12th) grade level; and c) be able to show means of adequate financial support and medical care.
3. We encourage international students to live within the District as they must be sponsored by a local resident(s).
4. The District, in its effort to promote international and cultural awareness, will seek a broad and diverse representation of students from a wide variety of countries. The actual number of students admitted will be contingent upon the District's ability to provide services as required.
5. When applications exceed the ability of the District to provide services, admissions shall be made in such a manner as to permit representation from as wide a diversity of countries as possible.
6. International students shall be required to pay tuition at a rate determined by the Board of Trustees.
7. The Board shall be informed by the Chancellor concerning the number of international students each Fall semester for the respective academic year.
