C. Academic Standards

5242 Issuance of Occupational Certificates *

1. Introduction

The District shall provide for the development of organized curricula which emphasizes technical competence as measured by the successful completion of prescribed course work. This curricula will be developed with input from Citizens' Advisory Committees. Upon the completion of required coursework, a Certificate of Achievement or a Certificate of Completion will be awarded to the student.

2. Criteria Standards

- a. A Certificate of Achievement will be awarded upon the successful completion of a minimum of twenty semester units of work in a prescribed curriculum, which includes courses related to the specialized occupation and which may include courses in general education appropriate to the occupation. A minimum grade point average of 2.0 is required.
- b. A Certificate of Completion will be awarded upon the successful completion of a prescribed curriculum related to the occupation and generally requiring a minimum of ten semester units. A minimum grade point average of 2.0 is required.
