C. Academic Standards

5270 Definition of Capability to Profit from Instruction *

Under provisions of the California State Education Code, the governing board of a community college district may admit to the community college any person:

1. who possesses a high school diploma or the equivalent thereof;
2. any apprentice who is **capable of profiting** from the instruction offered;
3. any other person who is 18 years of age or older who is **capable of profiting** from the instruction offered.

Under the provisions of the Education Code, the governing board of the District may by rule determine who is capable of profiting from the instruction offered.

It shall be the rule of this District that capability to profit from the instruction offered shall be determined by evidence of the individuals:

1. **capability to meet** the demands of college instruction at Chabot or Las Positas Colleges;
2. **capability to master** and proceed beyond the minimum basic skill levels required for success in college education;
3. **capability to show substantial progress** in cognitive and affective learning in college courses;
4. **capability** to show progress toward **independent learning**.

The procedures to determine the capability to profit from instruction are included in the Administrative Rules and Procedures.
