G. Matriculation

5610 Student Rights and Responsibilities

In accordance with the provisions of Title 5, Section 55530 (d), the Chabot-Las Positas Community College District adopts the following policy.

All students who enroll in college credit courses shall have the right to:

1. Participate in any matriculation activity regardless of exemption status.
2. Challenge course placement based upon the results of assessment procedures.
3. Enroll in courses for which prerequisites can be met.
4. File grievances regarding state-mandated matriculation requirements as outlined in the Administrative Rules and Regulations disseminated to all students. The grievance will be filed in accordance with the District Student Grievance Procedure as stated in the District Catalog.

All students who enroll in college credit courses shall have the responsibility to:

1. Participate in all matriculation activities, except those from which they have been exempted.
2. Adhere to all matriculation requirements as outlined in the Administrative Rules and Regulations disseminated to all students.
3. Present appropriate identification to indicate matriculation services used.
4. Submit final transcripts of high school(s) and/or college(s) attended in accordance with the District Admissions Policy.
