

## **Internal Board**

### **A. Authority & Organization of the Governing Board**

#### **7001 Organization and Authority**

The seven elected members plus the two non-voting student members subject to the requirements and limitations of Education Code Section 72023.5 shall constitute the Board of Trustees for the District. The State of California and the citizens of the Chabot-Las Positas Community College District vest the authority for the development, management, control and operation of all properties, programs, policies and procedures of the District and the colleges in the Board of Trustees. Board members shall have authority only when acting as a Board of Trustees legally in session.

The Board of Trustees may initiate and carry on any program or activity, or may otherwise act in any manner which is not in conflict with or inconsistent with, or preempted by, any law and which is not in conflict with the purposes for which the District was established.
