A. Authority & Organization of the Governing Board

7002 Trustee Election Districts

The seven publicly elected members of the Board of Trustees shall be elected from separate trustee areas. These trustee areas shall be apportioned so that each area is, as nearly as may be, of equal population density. The boundaries of these trustee areas shall be adjusted by the Board so that the population of each area is, as nearly as may be, the same proportion of the total population of the District as each of the other areas before the first day of March of the year following the year in which the results of each decennial federal census are released.

Each trustee shall reside in one trustee area and shall be elected by only the registered voters of that particular trustee area. Each trustee shall have resided in the trustee area from which he or she is elected not less than thirty (30) days prior to filing for candidacy. In accordance with Government Code Section 1770, if a Board member moves his or her residence from the trustee area to which the Board member was elected, the office shall be deemed vacant upon the event of the move.
