7003 Selection of Non-voting Student Member of the Board of Trustees *

Pursuant to the provisions of the Education Code, the following procedures are established to provide for the selection of two non-voting student members to the Board of Trustees, one from each college:

1. The election for the student members to the Board of Trustees shall be held concurrently with the elections of the Associated Students of both colleges during spring semester.
2. All students registered in the semester in which the election is held shall be eligible to vote in an election held pursuant to this policy upon presentation of their official registration cards.
3. A student's name shall be placed on the ballot or considered for appointment only upon written application and possession of the following minimum qualifications:
 - a. has completed at least six units of credit the previous semester at the college the student member would be representing;
 - b. is actively enrolled in six or more units of credit at the college the student member would be representing;
 - c. is in good academic and disciplinary standing;
 - d. has a cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or better;
 - e. is a resident of Chabot-Las Positas Community College District;
 - f. has submitted to the Vice President of Student Services in keeping with the deadlines given below, a nominating petition for the office of the non-voting student members of the Board of Trustees.
 - 1) For the general election, the deadline shall be on or before noon of the 14th day preceding the ASCC and ASLPC scheduled elections.

- 2) For special elections or provisional appointments, the deadline shall be on or before noon of the published date.
4. During the entire term of office for the non-voting student members of the Board of Trustees, the incumbents shall maintain residence in California, be actively enrolled in six or more units, and be in good academic and disciplinary standing.

Failure of the non-voting student members of the Board of Trustees to meet all of these conditions shall result in immediate disqualification.
5. When a vacancy occurs within the first half of an academic year, the Board of Trustees shall request that the ASCC or the ASLPC conduct a special election to fill the vacancy.

Should the vacancy occur during the last half of an academic year, the Board shall make a provisional appointment to fill the unexpired term. The names of all qualified candidates shall be presented to the Chancellor on or before the deadline established. The Chancellor will submit the names to the Board of Trustees.
6. The term of office for the non-voting student members of the Board of Trustees shall begin on May 15 for a period of one year, ending the following May 15.
