7014 Public Participation at Meetings

Upon recognition by the President of the Board, any members of the public may speak to any subject item on the agenda of the regular meeting. In addition, every regular meeting agenda shall provide an opportunity for members of the public to address the Board on items of interest to the public that are within the subject matter jurisdiction of the Board, provided that no action shall be taken on any item not appearing on the agenda unless otherwise authorized by law.

Members of the public may place items on the agenda. The items to be placed on the agenda must relate directly to District business. The determination of whether or not items to be placed on the agenda by members of the public relate to District business will be made by the Chancellor in consultation with the Board President. Items to be placed on the agenda by the public must be submitted on a form provided by the District at least ten (10) days prior to the next regular meeting of the Board of Trustees, along with all back-up material the person wishes to be considered by the Board.
