7050 Trustees Emeriti

It is the desire of the Governing Board to honor and to retain as a resource for the District the expertise and, as appropriate, the services of retiring Board Members. This policy for "Trustees Emeriti" is adopted to achieve this goal.

1. Qualifications for Trustees

A member of the Board of Trustees who has served two or more terms of office shall qualify for "Trustee Emeritus" status.

2. Recognition and Privileges

By action of the Governing Board, qualified retirees shall have the title "Emeritus" conferred upon them and shall have lifetime continuation of their names in the college catalog. Trustees Emeriti also shall be provided appropriate privileges consistent with Board policy and tradition.

3. Eligibility for Service to the District

With or without remuneration, as appropriate, all Emeriti shall be eligible for appointment within the scope of their credentials and qualifications to:

- a. serve on college committees in an advisory capacity;
- b. engage in special projects or studies;
- c. accept part-time assignments;
- d. perform administrative or supervisory functions.
