Government Code Section 54953.5

The Chancellor's Office is responsible for maintaining recordings of public Board meetings for a minimum of 30 calendar days following the meeting. After 30 calendar days, the recordings may be destroyed. The recordings shall be made available to the public and the news media in accordance with the California Public Records Act, Government Code Section 6250.

Copies of the recordings will be available to members of the public upon payment of the District's actual cost of reproduction.
