

**AP 4222 REMEDIAL COURSEWORK**

**Reference:**

Title 5 Section 55035

Remedial coursework consists of non-degree-applicable basic skills courses.

A student's need for remedial coursework shall be determined using appropriate assessment instruments, methods, or procedures.

No student shall receive more than 30 semester units for non-degree-applicable basic skills coursework. A student who exhausts this unit limitation shall be referred to appropriate adult noncredit education services.

Students enrolled in one or more courses of English as a Second Language and students identified as having a learning disability are exempt from the limitations of this procedure.

Students who demonstrate significant, measurable progress toward development of skills appropriate to enrollment in college-level courses may be granted a waiver of the limitations of this procedure.

The catalogs shall include a clear statement of the limited applicability of non-degree-applicable basic skills coursework toward fulfilling degree requirements and any exemptions that may apply to this limitation.
