The District maintains a plan for the provision of programs and services to disabled students designed to assure that they have equality of access to District classes and programs.

- procedure for timely response to reasonable accommodation requests involving academic adjustments which, at a minimum, provides for an individualized review of each such request, and permits interim decisions on such requests pending final resolution by the appropriate administrator or designee;
- long-range goals and short term objectives for the program;
- definitions of disabilities and students eligible for the program;
- support services and instruction that is provided;
- technology and accessibility;
- verification of disability;
- student rights and responsibilities;
- student educational contract or plan that is developed by a designated person in consultation with the student;
- academic accommodations;
- provisions for course substitution and waivers;
- staffing; and
- advisory committee.
