

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS
About Bidding a Project

Q. *Where can I find information about Bid No. 10-18?*

A. A copy will be made available on the District's website. To access the site go to www.clpccd.org Select "Bond Program" tab. On the left-side menu, select "Bidding/Project Business Opportunities". On the information page, under Public Projects select "Request for Formal Bids" and then find the applicable project – Bid No. 10-18.

Q. *What is the scope for this project?*

A. The scope for the PVC Roof Replacement, B3500, Chabot College project includes removal of existing roof, furnish and install of new PVC Roofing.

Q. *What is the Engineering Estimate for this project?*

A. The estimate for the PVC Roof Replacement, B3500, Chabot College project is \$150,000.00.

Q. *What does the bid document consist of?*

A. The bid document consists of Instruction for Bidders, Div. 01, Amtech Science Building Sciences' specifications and drawings.

Q. *Where can I purchase a set of plans for this project?*
