## Update on Budget Deficit

- Estimated shortfall remains at $\$ 25.4$ billion
- Proposed solutions
- $\quad \$ 12.5$ billion in spending reductions
- $\quad \$ 12.0$ billion in revenue extensions


## Legislative Analyst's Office (LAO)

- List of possible additional cuts if June tax ballot fails
- For community colleges (\$685 million)
- Increase in fee from $\$ 26$ to $\$ 66$ per unit
- Cap on state-funded credits of 90 units
- Reduce credit basic skills to non-credit


## Legislative Analyst's Office (LOA) (Con't)

- Eliminate state subsidy for intercollegiate athletics
- Eliminate state funding for repeat physical education and fine arts activity classes
- Eliminate state funding entirely for non-credit physical education and fine arts activity classes


## Assembly and Senate Budget Committees

- Rejected Governor's proposal to allocate funding through census reform
- Approved the CCC level of reduction
- $\$ 400$ million reduction in apportionment
- Increase fees from \$26 to \$36 per unit
- Rejected Governor's proposal to grow enrollment by $1.9 \%$


## State Chancellor's Comments

- Pleased that the census proposal was rejected by the Assembly and Senate Budget Committees
- Subcommittees agreed to "our insistence that the workload of community colleges be reduced in proportion to the $\$ 400$ million cut"
