**CurricuWare Development and Implementation**

Teleconference led by Janet Young from El Camino College. Ms Young is the college's Curriculum Committee Chair. She shared her experiences and insights on the implementation of an electronic curriculum software tool. She has been involved with the program from the start to the present—selection, inception and implementation.

CurricuWare was chosen by El Camino mainly based on cost considerations. CurriUNET was too expensive at the time. Their initial investment was \$30,000 which covered primarily the programmer costs. The programmer is an outside vendor who also charges an \$2,500 annual maintenance fee. The in-house ITS unit at El Camino is not involved with the development or maintenance of CurricuWare, but resides on the college's server. Ms. Young noted that development is still in the beginning stages, but has great potential. The programmer (Steve Barden) has been very responsive to their requests. At this time, CurricuWare is not tied to course scheduling or program review. El Camino would be receptive to any college/district that would like to join them in the development of CurricuWare and share costs.

Using the practice site, Ms. Young led the DCC through the various CurricuWare Menus.
