Banner 9 User Training is now available in preparation for the Migration from Banner 8 to Banner 9 in October 2018

District Information Technology Services (ITS) has been working over the past six months preparing for a major upgrade to our Banner System from Banner 8 to Banner 9. This major Banner System change will go live prior to the Spring registration cycle in November on the weekend of October 27-29. During this migration, Banner/CLASS-Web will be down beginning Friday night October 27 at 11 PM and continue through Sunday October 29 at noon. This phase of the Banner 9 upgrade in October does not change anything on CLASS-WEB, which is the Banner Self Service through the Web utilized primarily by faculty and students. This upgrade changes only the administrative screens/forms on the Internet Native Banner (INB) portion of the system.

A local installation of the Banner 9 System was completed in April in our Development/Test System that allows us to provide user access to the new Banner 9 System. ITS will begin providing user training sessions on May 7 throughout the months of May/June and continue the training through the summer as needed. Following the training, Banner users will be given access to the Test System to gain hands-on experience. ITS has contacted the various departments at the colleges and district to schedule their initial 2-hour user training session for their specific areas of responsibility. The appropriate managers and directors of these departments are coordinating with their staffs and ITS for the training sessions that will be held at different times at Chabot, Las Positas, and District for the current Banner users.
