MACC is funded by the Adult Education Block Grant and provides a forum for collaboration between adult schools and colleges. The Adult Education Symposium was held at the San Leandro Adult School and brought together both instructional and classified professionals from various agencies and disciplines to share promising practices in adult education and models of inter-agency collaboration.
