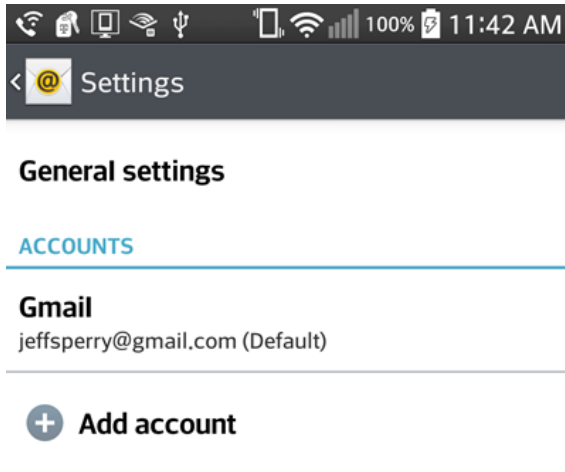
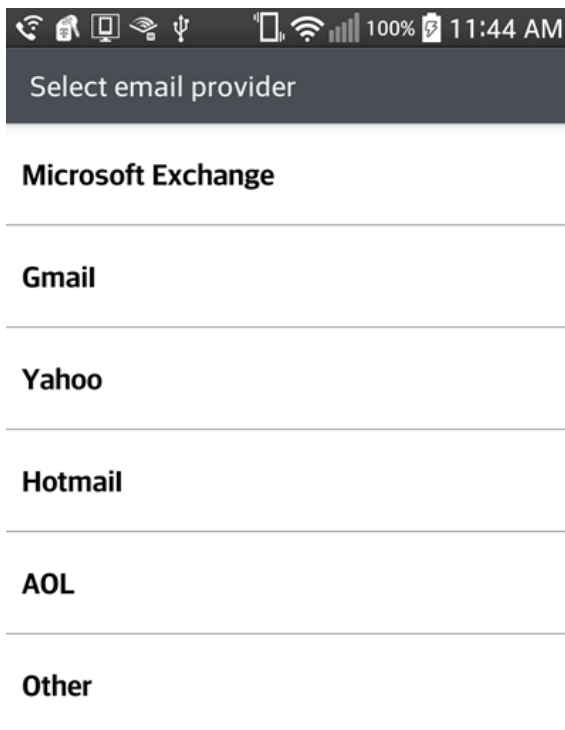


## How to set up an Android phone for Exchange email:


1. Open your email app and go to Settings. Select Add Account.



2. Select Microsoft Exchange.



3. Enter your full email address, password (this is your Active Directory password), and press Manual setup.

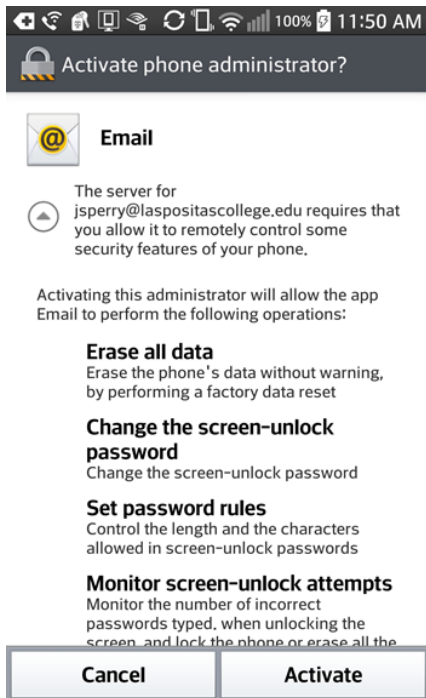

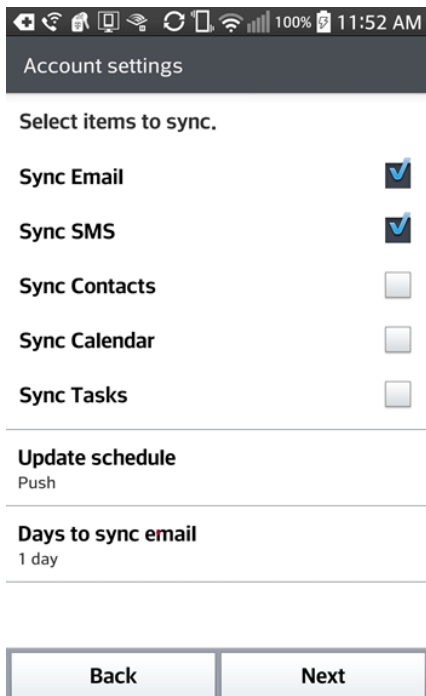

5. Press Next. Your device will set up. You will probably see this screen:




Press Activate.
