Approval of Agreement Renewal - City of Hayward, Chabot Security

Services, Chabot College

<u>Background</u>: For the past thirteen years, the District has contracted with the City of Hayward for the services of a Hayward Police Department Sergeant to serve as the Chabot College Director of Safety and Security. The agreement includes provisions for a contract extension with the agreement of both parties. The contract extension period is July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014 in the amount of \$231,858.

The cost of the Sergeant to the District for the period July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014 will be \$19,321.50 per month or \$231,858 for salary and benefits for the 2013-2014 fiscal year.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approves the proposed agreement renewal with the City of Hayward for Campus Security Services, Chabot College for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014 in the amount of \$231,858 for fiscal year 2013-2014. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the agreement on behalf of the District.

Approval of Standard Services Agreement Renewal Measure A Funds -

County of Alameda, Las Positas College

<u>Background</u>: The County of Alameda has secured funds from Measure A and will allocate \$20,000 to Las Positas College (LPC) to provide mental health services to its students in the Student Health and Wellness Center located on the LPC campus.

The scope of work included in this agreement includes a mental health services program which provides 20-28 hours of counseling services with a Marriage and Family Therapist (MFT) Intern. Additionally, the grant provides support for MFT Internship supervision. Students in emotional crisis are able to receive support through this program during the Fall and Spring semesters. The term of this agreement is September 30, 2013 through June 30, 2014. Alameda County Health Care Services did not submit the agreement until November 8, 2013.

The Board has approved a similar agreement for mental health services for students under item 5.5 on May 15, 2012.

<u>Recommended Action</u>: That the Board of Trustees approves the proposed standard services agreement renewal with the County of Alameda in the amount of \$20,000 for the term commencing September 30, 2013 through June 30, 2014. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the agreement on behalf of the District.

Approval of Amendment to Memorandum of Understanding – BMW of North

America, LLC, to Establish a BMW Associate Degree Program, Chabot

College

<u>Background</u>: On January 19, 2010, Chabot College entered into an agreement with BMW of North America, LLC to establish and operate a BMW sanctioned Associate Degree Program (ADP) effective in August, 2010. The initial term of the agreement ends on January 18, 2014.

This amendment extends the agreement for an additional six (6) months, from January 19, 2014 to July 19, 2014.

After four (4) years of operation, Chabot College will review the program over the next few months, and if necessary will make pragmatic, financial and contractual changes before entering into a long-term agreement.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approves the proposed Amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding –BMW of North America, LLC, to Establish a BMW Associate Degree Program, Chabot College for a term of six (6) months from January 19, 2014 to July 19, 2014. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the Amendment on behalf of the District.
