# **BACKGROUND INFORMATION -**

The Mid-Alameda County Consortium (MACC) was developed in response to AB86, the planning legislation that requires community colleges, K-12 districts, and community partners to develop regional plans for improving adult education. MACC includes twelve (12) member organizations: Chabot College, Las Positas College, Tri-Valley Regional Occupational Program (ROP), Eden Area ROP, Castro Valley Unified School District, Dublin Adult School, Hayward Center Adult School, Livermore Adult Education, New Haven Adult School, Pleasanton Adult and Career Education, San Leandro Adult School, and San Lorenzo Adult School. Consortia are required to provide evidence of member participation and appointment of representatives by their respective governing boards in accordance with AB104, the legislation guiding implementation of AB86 funds. There is no cost to the district for participating in the consortia since all expenses are covered through AB104.

The new Las Positas College nominee would replace Dr. Emerald Templeton and is aware of the goals and interests of the college and the District in advancing adult education in our region. ### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION -**

As part of the accountability measures for the Measure A Bond Program, the management team for the programs has put into place a formal process for managing, tracking and presenting to the Board of Trustees all revisions to the Measure A individual project names, scopes and budgets. This process adheres to the accountability standards outlined by Proposition 39 and provides transparency in the evolution of the project list.

Additional criteria added to the bond list revision process at the September 18, 2018 Board of Trustees meeting. These criteria identified an added layer of information and flagging to a bond list revision for those projects with substantive changes (a change to a single project in excess of \$5 million dollars, the cancellation of a project from the bond list, or the creation of a new project). In order to provide clarity for the Board of Trustees, the management team will identify bond list revisions containing "substantive changes" or "non-substantive changes in the agenda text.

Measure A Bond List revision #15 contains substantive changes based on the criteria set forth above. The Bond List Revision is proposing the following changes:

This revision creates a new project at Chabot College, three new projects at Las Positas College and new Districtwide Projects, Project number 562605 - Campus Security Phase 2 with a budget of \$750,000, Project Number 563704 - Guided Pathways with a budget of \$322,600, 563850 - Property Acquisition with a budget of \$450,000, Project Number 563935 - Central Utility Plant Wall with a budget of \$652,000, Project Number 561091 - 2024 Facilities Master Plan with a budget of \$750,000.

Other changes to budgets are to address budget savings and projected budget shortfalls of non-substantive level on smaller projects across the program.

- 562230 College Center: Transfer funds to 562601 Athletic Fields in amount of \$2,595,000 and to 562605 – Campus Safety Phase 2 in the amount of \$300,000.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION -**

On December 14, 2021, the Board of Trustees approved the Lease/Leaseback Contract with Blach Construction for pre-construction services for the STEM Complex (Biology Phase II) Project at Chabot College. On June 6, 2023, the Board of Trustees approved modification #01 for the early procurement of long lead items related to the design and construction of the project. By this action staff are recommending approval of Increment #02 for the remaining construction of the project based upon drawings submitted to the Division of the State Architect and negotiated alternate bid items for final approval.

Per Article 2, Item 11 establishing GMP and Milestone Schedule of said Lease Leaseback Agreement, the Contractor has successfully negotiated the GMP and milestone schedule for Increment 2: Construction of the Biology Phase II Building at Chabot College with District Staff. Work associated with Increment 2: Construction consists of 38 bid packages for which the District and the LLB Contractor received 132 bids.

The Contractor's Guaranteed Maximum Pricing for Increment 2: Construction of the Biology Phase II Building is within 3% of the 2023 revised construction budget of \$43,322,363 and is within the overall project budget for the project.

Pursuant to the Pre-Construction contract, the District will issue a Notice to Proceed to the LLB Contractor and enter into a separate Site Lease Agreement with Contractor (the "Site Lease"), under which it will lease the Project site described and depicted in Exhibit A1.

Upon completion of project, the Contractor will lease the Site and the Project back to the District pursuant to a separate Facilities Lease Agreement (the "Facilities Lease"), under which the District will be required to make lease payments to Contractor for the use and occupancy of the Site, including the Project for a (12) twelve-month period.
