Subject: Establishing Non-Resident (Out-of-State and International) Tuition Rates for 2009-2010

Background: In accordance with Education Code Section 76140, the Board of Trustees must set the non-resident tuition rate for the succeeding fiscal year. In establishing this amount, the District may select from one of the three options:

1. Statewide cost of education

The District served 373 full-time equivalent non-resident students in 2006-2007 and 381 in 2007-2008. The non-resident and international student tuition rate of \$180.00 per semester unit was charged for the 2008-2009 Academic Year. The administration recommends the rate of \$190.00 per semester unit for the 2009-2010 Academic Year.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approve the non-resident tuition rates for the 2009-2010 Academic Year; non-resident students; and international students, non-immigrant aliens attending on F-1 or other visa types, to be charged \$190.00 per semester unit.
