Subject: Approval of Grant Contract Renewal—Parent Resources for Information, Development and Education Training Program with Alameda County Social Services Agency, Children and Family Services, Chabot and Las Positas Colleges

Background: Chabot and Las Positas Colleges have received notification from the Alameda County Social Services Agency, Children and Family Services for the Parent Resources for Information, Development and Education (PRIDE) Training Program, of its intent to award a contract to continue delivery of program support training services.

The Colleges will offer childcare, food and related supplies/miscellaneous items to the participants of the pre-service PRIDE Training classes while they are attending these classes. The classes inform and prepare potential foster and adoptive parents in making successful, permanent connections with foster youth. The classes are open to kinship families, respite providers and the general public who are interested in understanding the needs of children in out-of-home care and are under the protection of the Department's Foster Care System.

The proposed contract renewal is in the amount of \$32,640 for the period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010.

The Board of Trustees approved the master contract on November 16, 2007 under item 4.5 for \$32,640 and a renewal on June 24, 2008 under item 4.4 for \$32,640.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approve the proposed grant contract renewal for the Parent Resources for Information, Development and Education Training Program with Alameda County Social Services Agency, Children and Family Services, Chabot and Las Positas Colleges, in the amount of \$32,640 for the period June 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the agreement upon receipt of the documents and any future augmentations or amendments on behalf of the District.
