Subject: Establishment of Non-Resident (Out-of-State and International) Tuition Rates for 2010-2011 Academic Year

Background: In accordance with Education Code Section 76140, the Board of Trustees must set the non-resident tuition rate for the succeeding fiscal year. In establishing this amount, the District may select from one of the three options:

1. Statewide cost of education
