Subject: Approval of Memorandum of Understanding–Safety Center, Incorporated,
District–Economic Development: OSHA Training Center

Background: Safety Center, Inc. is an organization founded in 1934 whose mission is to reduce injuries and save lives by providing safety education and training. They accomplish this mission by promoting lifelong safety and health through a variety of community and professional programs.

Safety Center, Inc. and the Chabot-Las Positas Community College District’s OSHA Training Center wish to create a Memorandum of Understanding to serve the training needs of those who are located in the Sacramento Valley and adjacent communities.

Courses presented shall include OSHA standards, occupational and environmental health and safety. The schedule of classes offered will provide individuals seeking to improve their knowledge of industrial safety, and to develop required safety skills within industries affected by OSHA requirements. Expenses and revenue for the classes will be shared by both parties.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approves the proposed Memorandum of Understanding between Safety Center, Incorporated and District – Economic Development, for the period June 7, 2010 through June 30, 2011. It is further recommended that the Board authorizes the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the agreement and any future augmentations or amendments to the agreement on behalf of the District.
