Subject: Acceptance of Agreement with Davis Street Family Resource Center in Support of the Governor's Gang Reduction and Prevention Initiative (CalGRIP), Chabot College

Background: This agreement of \$149,280 with Davis Street Family Resource Center supports establishing an *East Bay Teacher Pathway Program* (EBTP) that targets young adults ages 17-24 who are at-risk of gang involvement, gang involved or current gang members. The program establishes a teaching career pathway that provides postsecondary instruction, student support services and employment in local afterschool program, giving youth a positive and attractive alternative to gang life.

The targeted communities in this project are gang-impacted communities stretching from the Oakland border in East Oakland down to Fremont on the southern boundary of Alameda County to include: 1) San Leandro; 2) San Lorenzo; 3) Hayward; 4) Union City; 5) Newark; and 6) Fremont. Other partners include the Alameda County Workforce Investment Board (ACWIB), Hayward Unified School District, San Leandro Unified School District, California State University East Bay, Alameda County Office of Education (ACOE), California School Age Consortium (CalSAC), David & Lucille Packard Foundation, Boys & Girls Club of San Leandro, and Bay Area Community Resources (BACR).

Funding for the project is in the amount of \$149,280 for the period July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2012.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees accepts the proposed agreement with Davis Street Family Resource Center in the amount of \$149,280 for the period July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2012. It is further recommended that the Board authorizes the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the agreement and any future augmentations or amendments to the agreement on behalf of the District.
