Subject: Approval of Master Contract - County of Alameda, District-Economic Development

Background: Alameda County’s Social Services Agency has contracted with Chabot-Las Positas Community College District’s Economic Development department to provide training to group home providers, foster family agencies and Social Service Agency staff located in Alameda County since 2001.

It has been determined that one of the areas of training, the County’s Parent Advocates and Parent Leaders program, which brings parents with experience in the social services system together with parents who are negotiating the system for the first time, should be contracted separately from the rest of the Title IV-E program.

The contract is in the amount of \$201,925, for the period of July, 2010 to December, 2010. Unlike the Title IV-E federally funded training program where the Parent Advocates and Parent Leaders were housed previously, this is a straight fee for services contract, with no requirement of in-kind match required from the District.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approves the proposed Master Contract, County of Alameda, for the period July 1, 2010 through December 30, 2010, in the amount of \$201,925. It is further recommended that the Board authorizes the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the Master Contract and any future augmentations or amendments to the contract on behalf of the District.
