Subject: Establishing Non-Resident (Out-of-State and International) Tuition Rates for 2011-2012

Background: In accordance with Education Code Section 76140, the Board of Trustees must set the non-resident tuition rate for the succeeding fiscal year. In establishing this amount, the District may select from one of the three options:

1. Statewide cost of education

2. District cost of education based on 2009-2010 expense of education (base year)

\$189.00
\$157.00 capital outlay

3. Rate not to exceed that of a contiguous District

The District served 387 full-time equivalent non-resident students in 2008-2009 and 409 in 2009-2010. The non-resident tuition rate of \$195.00 per semester unit was charged for the 2010-2011 academic year. The administration recommends the rate of \$215.00 per semester unit for the 2011-2012 academic year, which includes a \$12.00 per unit capital outlay fee.

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Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approves the non-resident tuition rate of \$215.00 per semester unit for the 2011-2012 academic year for non-resident students, international students, and undocumented immigrants attending on F-1 or other visa types.
