Subject: Approval of Memorandum of Understanding – Tennyson High School to Reimburse Chabot College for Degree Applicable College Level Courses

Background: Chabot College and Tennyson High School wish to enter into an agreement allowing Tennyson High School to reimburse Chabot College for degree applicable college level credit courses to be offered to high school students during the Spring 2011 and Fall 2011 terms. Tennyson High School has received a Title I School Improvement Grant (SIG) and will utilize these funds to reimburse Chabot College for these courses. Because Tennyson is an underachieving school, part of their grant obligation is to improve their connection with higher education and increase opportunities for their students to attend college, including joining pathway cohorts that are currently being developed and in place at Chabot College.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approves the proposed Tennyson High School Memorandum of Understanding to provide college level courses in the instructional areas of Psychology, Sociology, Anthropology, Business, Music, Health and Protective Services during the Spring 2011 and Fall 2011 academic terms. It is further recommended that the Board authorizes the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the agreement and any future augmentations or amendments to the document on behalf of the District.
