Subject: Acceptance of Grant Sub-Award—East Bay Teacher Pathway 2011 Summer Science Institute with Growth Sector, Chabot College

Background: Chabot College is making a commitment with Growth Sector to administer the East Bay Teacher Pathway - Summer Science Institute for a total of \$28,350. The agreement is part of a Bechtel Grant received by Growth Sector and is in partnership with Chabot College, Exploratorium, Lawrence Hall of Science, Cal State University East Bay, UC Berkeley, and Davis Street Family Resource Center. The Summer Science Institute aims to expose the current East Bay Teacher Pathway cohort to inquiry-based science and math instructional methods, as well as enhance the learning in science and math for the cohort of future k-12 teachers. The sub-award funds faculty and staff time to embed inquiry-based strategies into existing courses and will cover the cost of the instruction of Chemistry 10, Engineering 10 and a math application workshop. The math application workshop is designed to assist students with the applied math content that appears in the chemistry course and is intended to provide contextualized math instruction.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees accepts proposed grant sub-award for the East Bay Teacher Pathway 2011 Summer Science Institute with Growth Sector, Chabot College in the amount of \$28,350, for the period June 1, 2011 through August 31, 2011. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the sub-award agreement and any future augmentations or amendments to the grant on behalf of the District.
