Subject: Approval of Amendment of Agreement - separate operating licenses—Eden Medical Center dba San Leandro Hospital, Sutter Medical Center, Castro Valley, Chabot College and Las Positas College

Background: Chabot College, through the programs of the Health and Natural Science Division, has maintained longstanding clinical relationships with various hospitals and healthcare facilities in the region to provide clinical experiences outside the standard classroom setting. Among these hospitals is Eden Medical Center, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation, located at 20103 Lake Chabot Road, Castro Valley, California and San Leandro Hospital, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation with facilities located at 13855 East 14<sup>th</sup> Street, San Leandro, California.

Past actions by the Board of Trustees approval for similar clinical agreements on January 19, 2010, with Children’s Hospital and Research Center, Oakland, for Surgical Technology, Las Positas College, Agenda 5.6; on December 8, 2009, with Stanford Hospital and Clinics, Las Positas College, Agenda 5.4; on March 18, 2003, Clinical Agreements with Various Hospitals and Healthcare Facilities, Chabot College, Agenda 5.4; August 21, 2001, Clinical Agreements with Various Hospitals and Healthcare Facilities, Agenda 5.6.d, May 18, 2010 under item 5.5.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approve the proposed Amendment to the agreement with Eden Medical Center, located at 20103 Lake Chabot Road, Castro Valley, California; and dba San Leandro Hospital, located at 13855 East 14<sup>th</sup> Street, San Leandro California, Sutter Medical Center, Castro Valley, Chabot College and Las Positas College for the period December 1, 2012 through May 1, 2014. It is recommended the Board accepts that Eden Medical Center and San Leandro reflect two acute care facilities currently organized to operate under one license will now operate under separate, respective licenses. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the Amendment on behalf of the District.
