Subject: Approval of Annual Cooperative Agreement No. 12-CCMUL-PUENTE-03 between the Regents of the University of California/Puente Project and Las Positas College

Background: The Puente Project was established for 2012-13 between the University of California and Las Positas College. The mission of the Puente Project is to increase the number of educationally underrepresented students who enroll in four-year colleges and universities, earn degrees, and return to the community as leaders and mentors to future generations. The first Puente Project was initiated at Chabot College in 1981. Since that time, the model has been replicated at 59 colleges and 34 high schools throughout the State of California, with the oversight of the Puente Project centralized through the Regents of the University of California.

- This is an agreement for six years – from July 1, 2012 to June 30, 2018.
- During the first three years of this agreement (2012 – 2013, 2013 – 2014, 2014 – 2015) the Puente Project will provide \$30,000 for capacity building funding per year and \$5,000 for operational costs per year.
- During the final three years of this agreement (2015 – 2016, 2016 – 2017, and 2017 – 2018) Las Positas College shall contribute, from its own or third-party resources, program operating costs at a minimum of \$5,000 for expenditures.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approves the proposed annual Cooperative Agreement No. 12-CCMUL-PUENTE-03 between the Regents of the University of California/Puente Project and Las Positas College from July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the agreement on behalf of the District.
