

Synopsis of the AB86 Adult Education Grant

The guidelines and procedures to access the AB86 funding (Certificate of Eligibility terms) were released on December 19, 2013.

AB86, Section 76 provides a planning and implementation grant for adult educational regional consortia, comprised of community college districts and school districts for the purpose of developing regional plans to:

- better serve the educational needs of adults
- create seamless transitions to postsecondary education
- address existing gaps in programs and services

Our planned consortia agreement with local elementary and secondary schools in the area of basic skills including HSD/GED, ESL, citizenship, adults with disabilities, CTE and apprenticeships.
