## INDEPENDENT AUDITORS REPORT

We have audited the accompanying financial statements of CHABOT - LAS POSITAS COLLEGES FOUNDATION (a nonprofit organization) which comprise the statement of financial position as of June 30, 2013, and the related statements of activities and cash flows for the year then ended, and the related notes to the financial statements.

### **Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements**

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America; this includes the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

### **Auditor's Responsibility**

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit. We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. Accordingly, we express no such opinion. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

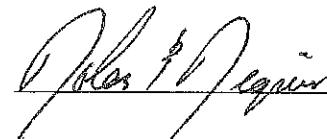
We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion.

In our opinion, the information is fairly stated in all material respects in relation to the financial statements as a whole.

NOTES TO FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

June 30, 2013

**NOTE A - DESCRIPTION OF ORGANIZATION**

The Chabot - Las Positas Colleges Foundation is a not-for-profit corporation. The Foundation was formed to solicit and accept funds to enrich, expand and better equip programs, to recognize excellence in teaching, and provide grants and scholarships for students.

**NOTE B - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES**

The financial statements of the Foundation have been prepared on the accrual basis. Additionally, the Foundation has implemented Financial Accounting Standards 116, Accounting for Contributions Received and Contributions Made, and 117, Financial Statements for Not-For-Profits Organizations.

Fund Accounting - To insure observance of limitations and restrictions placed on the use of resources available to the organization, the accounts of the Foundation are maintained in accordance with the principles of fund accounting. This is the procedure by which resources are classified for accounting and reporting purposes into funds established according to their nature and intended use. Separate accounts are maintained for each fund; however, in the accompanying financial statements, funds that have similar characteristics have been combined into fund groups. Accordingly, all financial transactions have been reported by fund group. A schedule accompanying the financial statements shows each fund separately.

The unrestricted fund represents the portions of expendable funds that are available for support of the Foundations operations at the discretion of the board of directors.

The restricted funds are created to observe the limitations placed on the use of the resources by the respective donors. Restrictions vary from what portion of the fund is available for use to what purpose the available funds can be applied.

Cash and Cash Equivalents - Cash equivalents include all highly liquid instruments that are readily available in demand deposit, money market accounts, or certificates of deposit with maturity dates of three months or less.

Promises to Give - It is the policy of the Foundation not to record contributions until they are received. The Foundation does encourage bequests, the total number and amount of which are not known until the closure of the respective estates. As of June 30, 2013, there were no conditional or unconditional promises to give that required disclosure.

**NOTE B - SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (continued)**

Investments - Marketable securities are reflected on the balance sheet at fair market value. Investment income includes changes in market value.

Donations - Donations of marketable securities are recorded at the fair market value at the time of donation.

Investment income - Income is allocated to the restricted and unrestricted funds based on the balances at the beginning of the year. No income is allocated to pass-through accounts whose funds are donated for specific purposes or programs and are to be disbursed within a predetermined time period, or accounts that have not attained a minimum balance of \$2,500 within three years. Unrealized appreciation on investments is allocated to unrestricted reserves and is not available for expenditure until the appreciation is actually realized.

Volunteer services - Members of the board of directors and others contribute their time to the Foundation. No amounts are reflected in the accompanying financial statements for their services as no objective basis is available to measure the value of these services.

Income tax status - The Foundation is exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code. As such all contribution made to the Foundation qualify for the maximum deduction. An organization exempt from taxes pursuant to this code section is taxed only on unrelated business income. The Foundation did not report unrelated business income for the year ended June 30, 2011.

**NOTE C - THIRD PARTY REIMBURSEMENTS**

Chabot - Las Positas Community College District provides office space and office supplies to the Foundation at no cost.
