



**AGREEMENT BETWEEN
CITY OF DUBLIN**

AND

Chabot-Las Positas Community College / Tri-Valley One Stop Career Center

THIS AGREEMENT, dated for identification this first day of July, 2015, is entered into between the City of Dublin ("City") and Chabot-Las Positas Community College / Tri-Valley One Stop Career Center (Grantee).

RECITALS

- A. Grantee has asked City to contribute \$12,000 (Twelve Thousand Dollars) for use by Grantee to cover Project Dublin costs in order to provide the services as described in Exhibit A. The services rendered pursuant to this agreement will be for the period July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016.
- B. City has determined that it is in the interest of the residents of the City of Dublin to make a donation of \$9,600 (Nine Thousand Six Hundred Dollars) for such purpose, provided certain conditions are met to ensure that the services will benefit the residents of City.

AGREEMENT

City and Grantee agree as follows:

- 1. Recitals
The foregoing recitals are true and correct and are part of this agreement.
- 2. City Donation
City shall donate \$9,600 (Nine Thousand Six Hundred Dollars) to be used by Grantee for operational support for Project Dublin as described in Exhibit A to this Agreement. The donation shall be paid upon invoice to the City. Grantee understands that use of funds for any purpose not approved as part of the grant award, and/or any use not in compliance with Community Grant Program Guidelines will result in forfeiture of funds for this grant period and potential ineligibility for future funding.
- 3. Records
Grantee shall maintain records for project/program review, evaluation, audit and/or other purposes and make them available to City upon request.
- 4. Periodic Reports
Upon request by City, Grantee shall provide reports describing the progress made by Grantee accomplishing the goals and objectives outlined in the work plan.

Chabot-Las Positas Community College / Tri-Valley One Stop Career Center Project Dublin
