

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

Las Positas Community College

AND

PORTIA BELL HUME BEHAVIORAL HEALTH AND TRAINING CENTER

PURPOSE

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into by Las Positas Community College (LPC) and the Portia Bell Hume Behavioral Health and Training Center (aka The Hume Center) for the purpose of providing behavioral health services including: assessment, treatment, case management and collateral for students up to the age of 21 years and 11 months and have Medi-Cal as their primary health insurance carrier as well as for students who are on CalWORKs irrelevant of age. For students over 22 years of age and have Medi-Cal as their primary health insurance carrier, services will include assessment, treatment, and collateral. These services are for students who are enrolled at Las Positas Community College. This MOU is effective as of October 19th, 2016 through August 15, 2017.

SERVICES PROVIDED

The Hume Center will:

1. Employ and/or contract, train, and provide ongoing supervision for a mental health clinician/trainee (a trainee refers to a psychology graduate practicum student, intern and/or post-doctoral fellow) who will be placed at Las Positas Community College to provide the above stated behavioral health services to the referenced student population described above. The Hume Center will ensure that the mental health clinician/trainee is qualified to perform duties described above under the supervision of The Hume Center's Licensed Psychologist, unless such person is a licensed clinician.
2. Provide a mental health clinician/trainee to be available up to 15 hours per week. Upon initial implementation of the program the mental health clinician/intern will begin seeing students 5-7 hours per week with possible expansion to 10-15 hours weekly.
3. The Hume Center will document all mental health services that are performed with students in Hume Center's mental health records and according to Hume Center's charting and paperwork policies and procedures. Documentation will include documentation according to standards of care issued by Medi-Cal and will be kept at The Hume Center office in Pleasanton.
4. Mental health services may include direct services to the client, as well as gathering information and providing consultation to family members, and collateral individuals (such as college clinicians and professors).
5. Participate in Las Positas Community College multidisciplinary team meetings/case conferences to discuss both students and clinic operations.
6. Help protect privacy and confidentiality of Las Positas Community College students and students' medical and mental health records.
7. Work collaboratively to share space, and resources, while simultaneously maintaining client confidentiality.
