This is a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the Chabot-Las Positas Community College District/Tri-Valley One-Stop Center (TVOS) and Habitat for Humanity East Bay/Silicon Valley (Habitat) in regard to providing financial education workshops and counseling during the 2016-2017 fiscal year.

- TVOS will market and recruit individuals for the workshops and guidance session to the best of their ability

This MOU will be in effect from date agreement is signed until June 30, 2017 and is subject to annual renewal provided all parties are in agreement.
