Subject: Approval of Internship Agreement between King and American Ambulance Service of San Francisco and Chabot-Las Positas Community College District, Las Positas College

Background: Las Positas College requires students in the Emergency Medical Training-Paramedic (EMT-P) program to successfully complete field internships. Similar requirements exist within allied health programs at Chabot College. The district has benefitted from a previous agreement with King and American Ambulance Service (King-American), to be a service provider for the Las Positas College EMT-P program.

The purpose of this agreement is to continue the relationship with King-American and establish the respective responsibilities and duties of the colleges and King-American while students are participating in field internship programs. King-American will provide field internships for the purpose of training students enrolled in the Las Positas College EMT-P program, and training will be under the supervision of an experienced King-American employee who shall be selected in accordance with the Las Positas College EMT-P program requirements at no cost to the district. The agreement by its terms also includes Chabot College.

The agreement will commence on November 1, 2018 extending through October 31, 2022. This agreement is for a term of twenty-four (24) months, though the agreement may be terminated by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approves the proposed Internship Agreement between King and American Ambulance Service of San Francisco and Chabot-Las Positas Community College District, Las Positas College. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute this agreement on behalf of the District.
