Subject: Acceptance of Grant Agreement No. 18-081-102 – California Community

Colleges Chancellor's Office, District-Economic Development

<u>Background:</u> Chabot-Las Positas Community College District (CLPCCD) has been awarded a grant by the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office (CCCCO) to serve as the fiscal agent for the California Community Colleges Core Applications Project. This program will improve student engagement and operational efficiency by stabilizing, optimizing and expanding adoption of systemwide applications, platforms and tools previously deployed through the Education Planning Initiative (IEPI), the Technology and Telecommunications Infrastructure Program (TTIP) and the Strong Workforce Program (SWP).

Under the terms of this grant agreement, the role of fiscal agent requires that we create and implement contracts with vendors for data collection and reporting curriculum and program creation and distribution, technology purchases, and process invoices against those contracts, as directed by the CCCCO staff assigned to oversee this program. There is a standard contract format utilized with the vendors.

The award amount of the CCCCO Grant Agreement No. 18-081-102 is \$3,300,000. The funding period for this grant is from September 18, 2018 to June 30, 2019. The effective date for this grant is October 17, 2018, upon approval by the Board of Trustees.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees accepts the proposed Grant Agreement No. 18-081-102 – California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office, District-Economic Development, in the amount of \$3,300,000, for the period of September 18, 2018 to June 30, 2019. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the agreement on behalf of the District.
