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If Students have an IEP or 504 plan in High School

Students can make an appointment with the Disabled Student Resource Center [DSRC](#) counselor to review their IEP/504 plan to see if they are eligible for accommodations.

DSRC services are confidential, completely voluntary and may provide supports for students to be successful in college courses.

Students also might consider taking LNSK 116 before deciding on an English and/or Math course.



Students have the right to access College level English Courses

English 1/1A is a college level English course. This course is transferable to a four year university.

English 101A and 102 are not college level English courses. They are not transferable to a four year university.

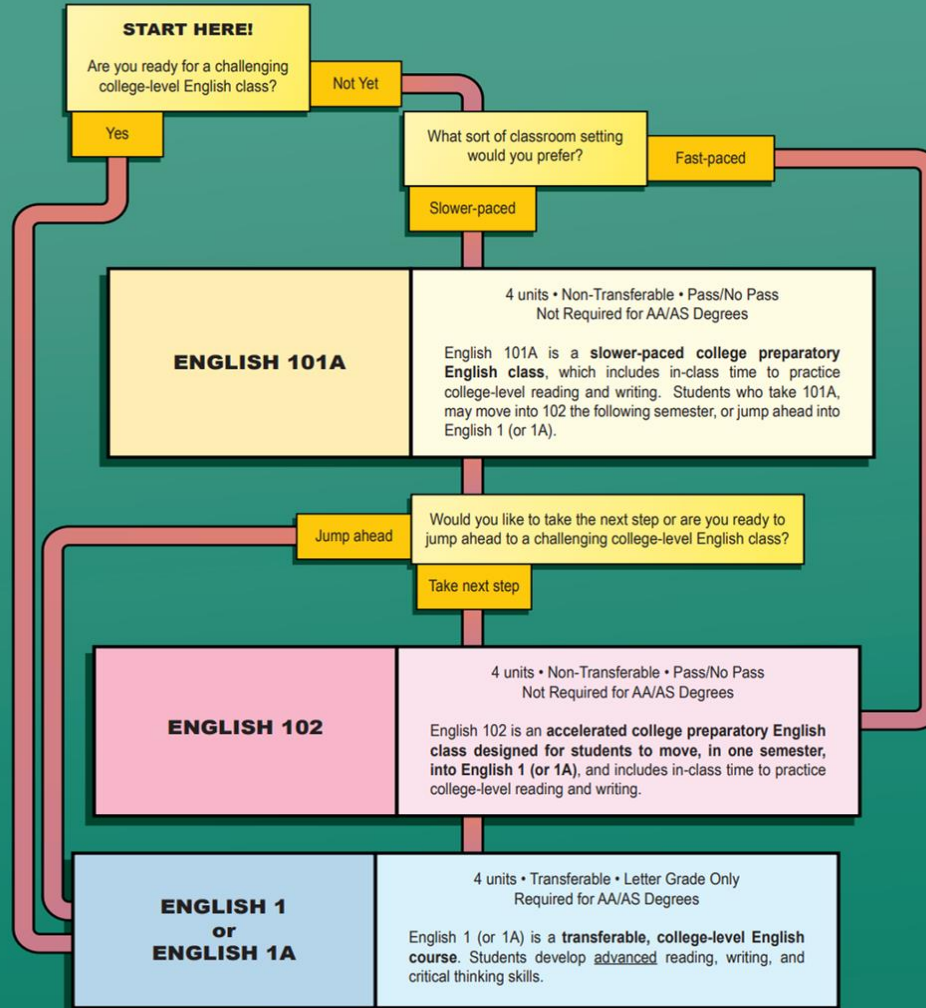
Students have the right to choose which course best suits their needs. A counselor can help support students explore their options.

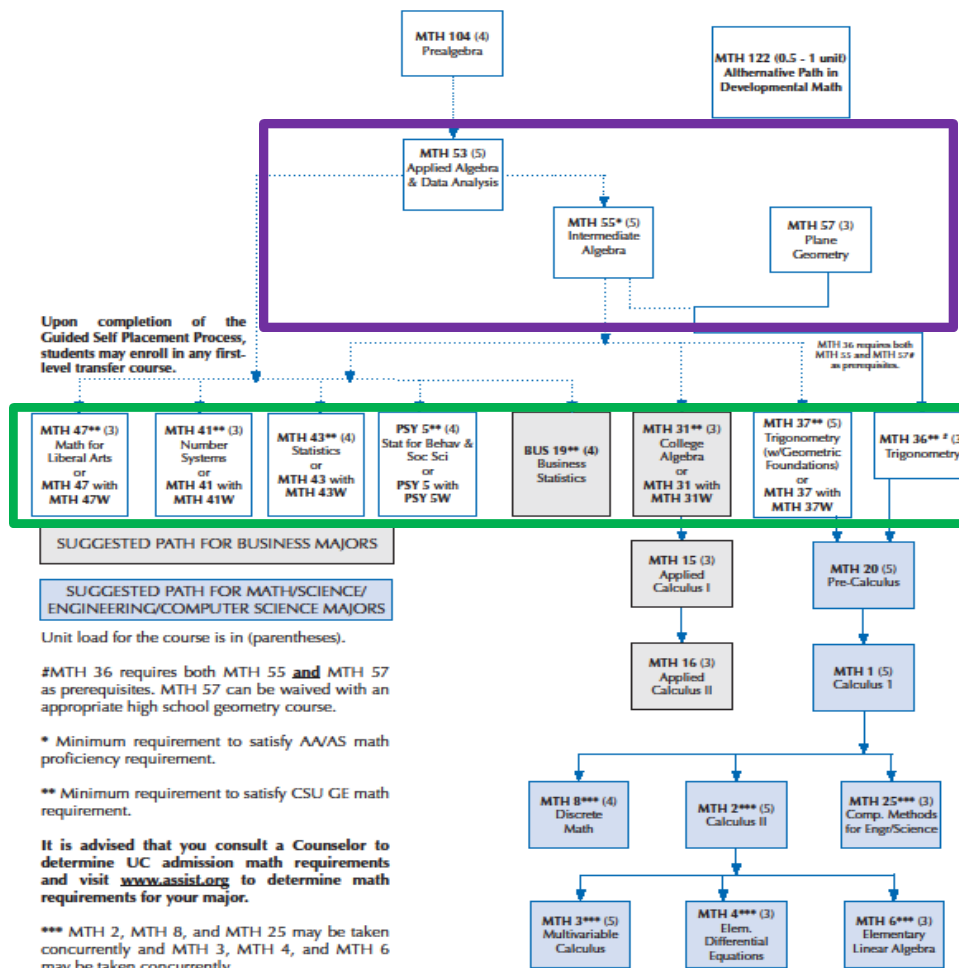
ENGLISH INFORMED COURSE SELECTION

The purple box holds all Math courses that meet minimum Math proficiency levels for Associates Degrees only

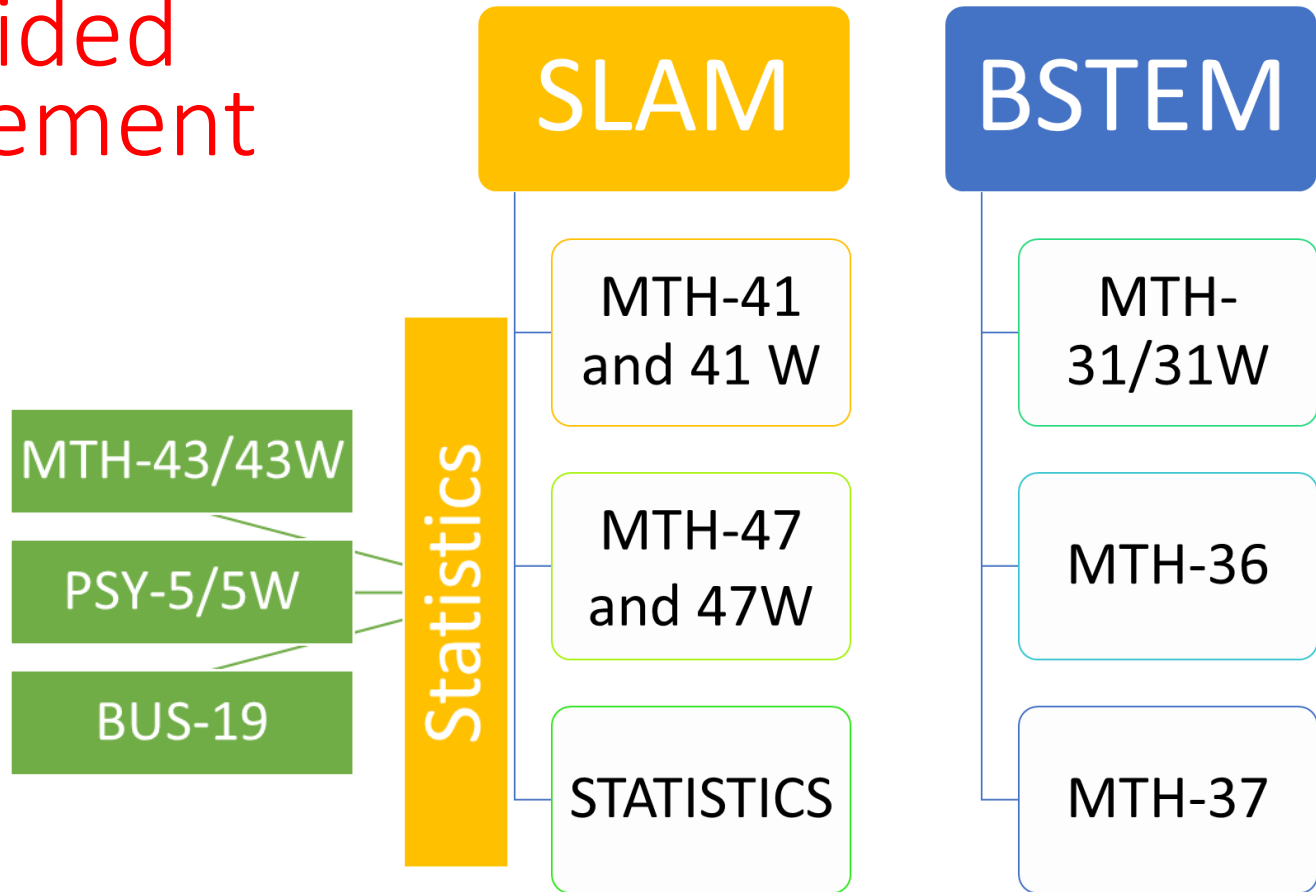
The green box holds all Math courses that are college level, and meet minimum requirements for transfer.
