Goals of Engagement

Short Term (January – July 2020)

Advocate for and win the California Community College Board of Governors request for \$780 million in additional funding (7.5% increase) in the 2020-21 State Budget

- \$297 million for the Student -Centered Funding Formula (SCFF)
- \$250 million for Financial Aid Reform

Continue advocacy to reform the Student-Centered Funding Formula (SCFF)

Longer Term

Chabot - Las Positas Community College District Chancellor and Trustees will be well known thought leaders driving higher education policy at in State and Local government

- Increase visibility of CLPCCD in Sacramento
- Position CLPCCD leadership as a trusted voice for higher ed for policy makers

Deliverables:

- Coordinate with CLPCCD Public and Government Affairs to create messaging and a compelling narrative for the importance of adequately funding California's Community Colleges, focused on CLPCCD
- Support effort to build a coalition of Bay Area Community College Districts and manage coordination of the coalition
- Develop and implement a strategic legislative engagement blueprint for local policy makers and legislators in Sacramento
- Develop and implement a workplan for the cultivation of third-party champions and advocates


Fundamentals

- Expand and enhance relationships with local elected officials, members of the Bay Area legislative caucus
- Identify and develop local legislative champions and advocates

Legislative Engagement

- In coordination with Regional partners and the CCC Board of Governors, identify and develop legislative champions
 - Budget Committees and Sub Committees in Assembly and Senate
 - Education Committees in Assembly and Senate
 - Higher Education Committee in Assembly
