**RE:** Intent to Award Notification for Rising Scholars Network Request for Application (RFA)

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This memorandum is a formal notification of the intent to award the applicants of Rising Scholars Network grants from the Educational Services and Support Division of the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office.

The California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office, Educational Services and Support Division acknowledges the quality of applications and the ability to meet diverse goals and regional needs. Pending Board of Governors approval as well as the availability of funds, the term of the grant is July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2025. A list of the project applications and their funding status is below.

The grant applications were reviewed and competitively scored. Applications were assigned in rank order:

1. Eligible Funded: Proposals in this category received the minimum number of points and were funded through the top 59 applicants.
2. Not Eligible: This category includes proposals that did not achieve the minimum number of points on the evaluation.

Applicants have until April 19, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. PST to enter an appeal letter. The appeal must be in writing and be signed by the District Superintendent/Chancellor or designee. Appeals must be filed with the Vice Chancellor of the Educational Services and Support division responsible for funding the project (as identified in the RFA). The appeal must specify the grounds of appeal and must be based on the process and/or procedures used in the review and recommendation of applications for awards. The Vice Chancellor shall review all the information submitted with the appeal, consult with the Office of General Counsel where necessary, and render a decision within 30 calendar days of the date of receipt of the appeal. The decision of the Vice Chancellor is final.

The Chancellor's Office will contact the district receiving funding to request agreement face sheets and any technical changes, including budgets, that are needed to complete the execution of the grant agreement. A copy of the fully executed grant agreement will be emailed to the district. For audit purposes, funded districts must retain a copy of the grant agreement, the RFA specifications, and the Educational Services and Support Division request for applications instructions and terms

and conditions. Collectively, these documents constitute the legally binding agreement to perform the specified work.
