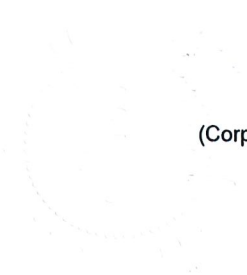

Work performed at the determination and direction of the District under this Allowance shall be documented by Contractor and submitted to Construction Manager per the requirements specified in Article 9 of the General Conditions. Contractor shall include a separate line item in

Contractor's Schedule of Values as "Allowance" with the value of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00). At closeout of Contract, any funds remaining in the Allowance shall be credited to Owner through a Change Order.

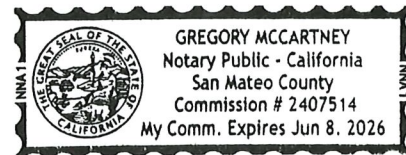
