Subject: Approval of Contract Renewal Amendment— Alameda County Social Services Agency, Children and Family Services for the Community Action to Reach Out to Infants (CARI) Program, Chabot-Las Positas Community College District, Chabot College

Background: Chabot College has received notification from the Alameda County Social Services Agency of its intent to renew a grant for the continuation of services for the Community Action to Reach Out to Infants (CARI) Program.

Under the CARI Program, the College provides specialized, pre-designed training for potential Resource Families (previous foster parents, kinship caregivers) and Respite Providers to care for children that enter Alameda County’s Child Protective Services through drug exposure, HIV, neglect or abuse. This will be the nineteenth year the Alameda County Board of Supervisors has chosen to reconfirm its dedication to the ideals of service to the community through the maintenance of this partnership with the College.

The Alameda County Social Service Agency will recommend for approval, to the Alameda County Board of Supervisors, the grant renewal amount of \$39,977. The contract is effective for services rendered from July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023. The Board of Trustees initially approved this grant in 2003, as item 4.2 of the August 19, 2003 meeting agenda. The most recent renewal was in 2021, under item 4.3 of the December 14, 2021 meeting agenda for \$39,797.

Recommended Action: That the Board of Trustees approves the proposed Contract Renewal Amendment with Alameda County Social Services Agency, Children and Family Services for the Community Action to Reach Out to Infants (CARI) Program, Chabot-Las Positas Community College District, Chabot College, in the amount of \$39,977 for services rendered from July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023. It is further recommended that the Board authorizes the Vice Chancellor, Business Services, to execute the contract on behalf of the District.
