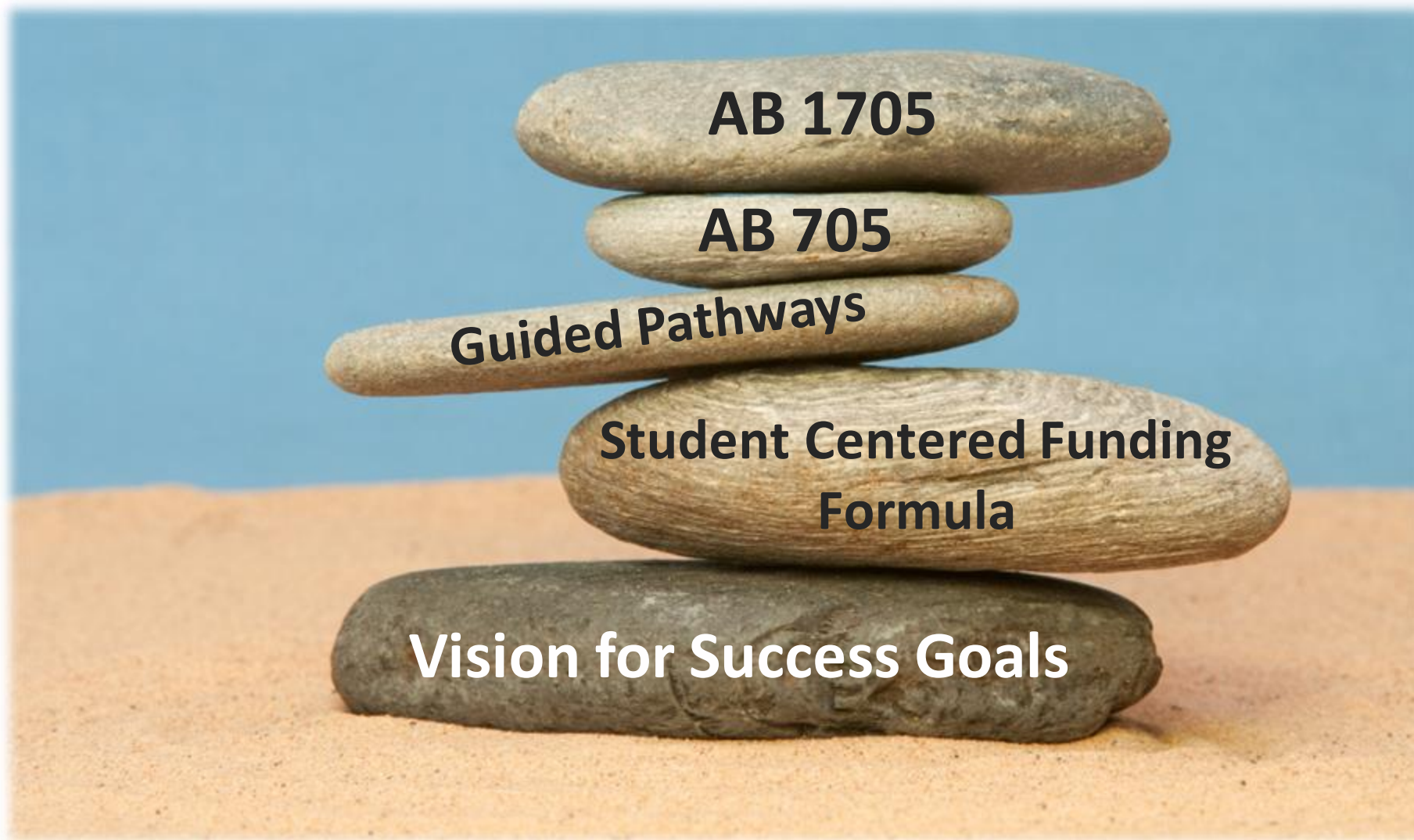

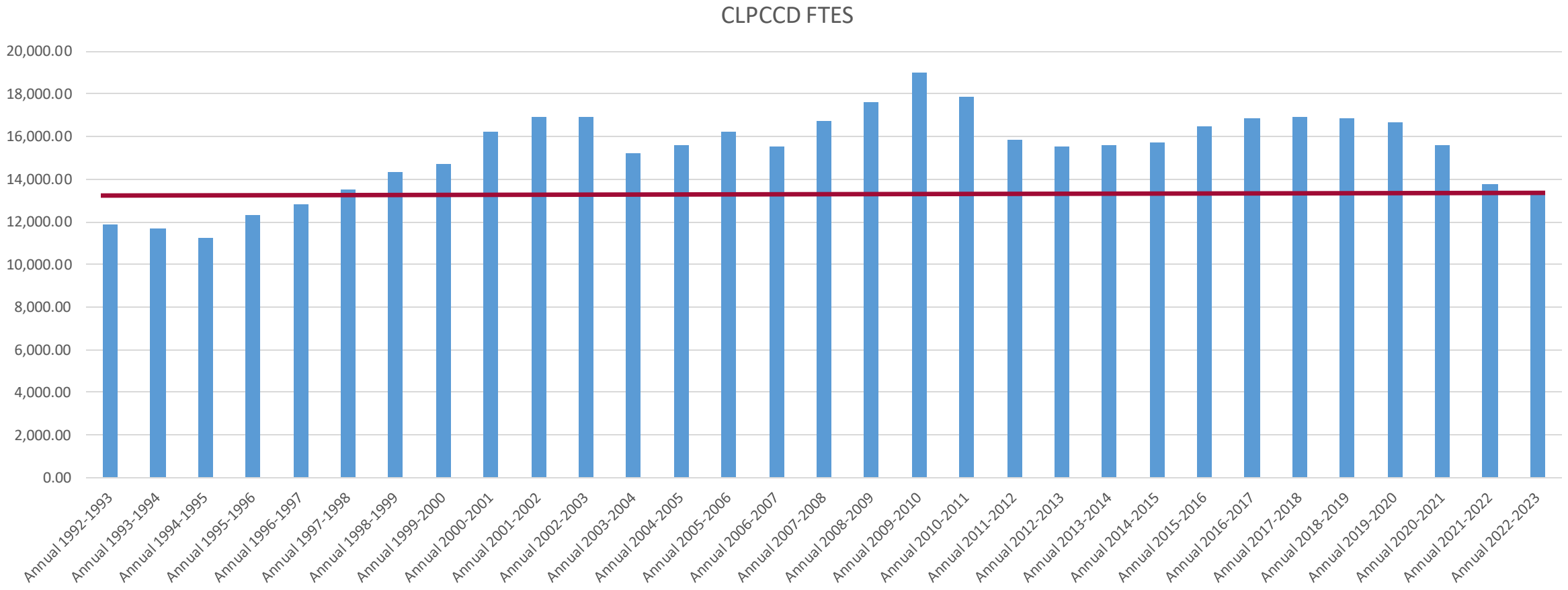
Changing Landscape

Current Enrollment Update

Summer:

- Chabot and Las Positas approximately 11% increase over summer 2022

Fall:

- Chabot College approximately 11% increase over fall 2022
- Las Positas College approximately 20% increase over fall 2022



SCFF – Hypothetical Example

Ron (hypothetical student) just earned his ADT and is both a Pell and Promise Grant recipient. Assuming "Ron" took a full load:



Previous funding model:

FTES 1 = \$7,449.61

Total funding = \$7,449.61

Student Centered Funding Formula:

FTES 1: $\$4,840.49 / (2/3) = \$3,226.99$

Supplemental: 2 pts @ \$1,144.62 = \$2,289.24

Success Allocation: 14 pts = \$6,550.57

Total funding: = \$12,066.80

The SCFF provides over \$4,600 in additional funding for the same hypothetical student!
