#### CALL TO ORDER

## REVIEW, DISCUSSION AND APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

It was moved (Mr. Doug Horner), seconded (Ms. Gordon Watt), and passed that the minutes of the October 23, 2015 (No.9) meeting be approved as corrected.

### 2015-16 Space Inventory and Cap Load Ration

Ms. Zahra Noorivaziri explained that Space Inventory is updated and submitted to the State Chancellor's Office on October 1 of each year by District / Facilities Dept.

The space inventory report provides detail on the age, condition, and gross square feet and usage of the rooms with the building.

The usage elements provide a basis of sorting by room type (lecture, lab, office, library and audio-visual).

Based on this report the state determines the Capacity to Load ratio:

This ratio, expressed as percent. Ratios above 100% indicate an excess of space, ratios below 100% indicate deficiency of space.

## LPC Building 2100 Renovation – Added Project

Mr. Horner reported that the renovation of building 2100 Faculty Offices at Las Positas College was requested by the college. The district senior leadership team authorized to proceed. The scope of project is new carpet, new paint, new furniture and new ceiling. The renovation is scheduled for this summer of 2016. The total budget for this project is estimated about \$600,000 to \$800,000. Roughly half of the budget is coming from Las Positas College and the other half is from Measure B district wide budget.

## • 2016 Bond Issue Update

Mr. Horner reported that the next Board Meeting will be on Tuesday March 1, 2016. The Board of Trustees will consider a Bond for \$950,000,000 for June 7, 2016. If the Bond passes, the split between colleges will be determined by the Board of Trustees. Polling on the proposed bond shows strong support by taxpayers, and the lower bond amounts receive weaker support.
