BP 3445 PETS AND ANIMALS

Reference(s): N/A

No owner or keeper of a dog shall allow or permit such dog, whether licensed or unlicensed, on the campuses or district facilities, unless it is securely restricted by a substantial leash not to exceed six feet in length. The dog shall be under the control of a person competent to keep it under effective charge and control.

Any dogs on the campuses or district facilities in violation of this regulation may be impounded by the District or local animal control officers. .

No dogs are permitted to enter any of the buildings on the campuses. Students bringing dogs on campus in compliance with the local City or County leash requirements will provide for adequate care and control for those dogs in order to avoid inhumane conditions or treatment while students are attending classes.

Other animals and pets are prohibited on the campuses or district facilities at any time unless special circumstances warrant, in which case clearance must be obtained in advance from the appropriate chief business officer.

Service animals (dogs and miniature horses) for persons with disabilities and emotional support animals approved as a disability-related accommodation are exempt from the access restrictions of this policy. Also see BP/AP 3440 titled Service Animals.
