BP 4225 COURSE REPETITION

Reference:

Education Code Section 76224

Title 5 Sections 55040, 55041, 55042, 55043, 55253, 56029, and 58161

Students may repeat courses in which substandard grades (less than "C," and including W, "FW," "NP," or "NC) were earned. Reasonable limitations on course repetition are described in AP 4225 titled Course Repetition.

When course repetition occurs, the permanent academic record shall be annotated in such a manner that all work remains legible, insuring a true and complete academic history.

Under special circumstances, students may repeat courses in which a C or better grade was earned. The special circumstances are defined in AP 4225 Course Repetition.
