Lieutenant Colonel spent time in Thailand, Germany and Saudi Arabia and supported the operational development of the F-117 Stealth Fighter.

Maduli holds an Associate of Arts from Hartnell College, Bachelor of Science in aeronautical engineering from California Polytechnic State University in San Luis Obispo, Master of Science in aeronautical engineering from the University of Oklahoma and Masters in Business Administration from Golden Gate University. He is currently working toward an Education Doctorate in educational leadership from the University of Southern California.

Maduli currently serves as Board President on CLPCCD Board of Trustees of which he has been an elected member since 2016 representing Area 7, which includes Livermore and parts of Pleasanton. Maduli serves as the Vice Chancellor of Administrative Services for the West Valley-Mission Community College District in Santa Clara County. He previously held the roles of Assistant Superintendent/Vice President of Administrative Services for the San Luis Obispo County Community College District at Cuesta College in San Luis Obispo, the district's Interim Superintendent/President and Director of Fiscal and Administrative Operations and the Vice President of Business Services for Las Positas College.

Since 1988, the Walter Starr Robie Award, which was presented on October 29 at the 2019 ACBO Fall Conference in San Diego, has been given to California community college business administration who have demonstrated outstanding achievements and exemplary service as chief business officials in their respective districts throughout California.
